I, the parent of _____, fully understand the risks involved in dance, gymnastics and exercise programs and will not hold Fascinatin' Rhythm Studio of Dance, its owners or staff, responsible for accident or injury, jointly and separately, from all personal injury claims arising through or from participation in activities as a student of Fascinatin' Rhythm Studio of Dance in or upon the premises of the above named studio/school.

I, _____, agree to pay monthly installments for myself or my child's classes on the first of each month. If I fail to pay all fees (tuition, costume and recital) by the 10th of the month I will add a \$15.00 late fee. If for any reason my check should be returned to Fascinatin' Rhythm Studio of Dance, I agree to pay a \$35.00 returned check fee. Fascinatin' Rhythm Studio of Dance reserves the right to refuse any of the studio services if the account is delinquent. A non-refundable recital fee of \$65.00 is due at registration. Costume **deposits** of \$75.00 per costume is due in October. **Adjustments will be made in March.**

Tuition is calculated on an annual basis and divided into 11 equal monthly installments - August through June. Studio holidays are taken into consideration and rehearsals at the end of the year are included. December and June must be paid in full. Missed classes will not be refunded or credited, but a make-up may be scheduled within the month. You will need to call the office to schedule. **You may withdraw from classes with a 30 day written withdraw note to Fascinatin' Rhythm Studio of Dance.**

2009-2010 Studio Information

Registration

There is a **\$30 per student per school year fee**. This fee is non-refundable. Students who drop out temporarily will be required to renew registration (\$20.00). All students must register in person to complete the registration form and those under 18 must have a parent or guardian present at the time of registration. Dancers will not be allowed to take classes without a completed and signed registration form.

Monthly Rates *These hours can be combined family members or just one student.

1 hour per week	\$ 50.00 per month
1 ½ hours per week	\$ 65.00 per month
2 hours per week	\$ 80.00 per month
2 ½ hours per week	\$ 95.00 per month
3 hours per week	\$105.00 per month
Each additional hour	\$ 25.00 per month
11+ hours per week	\$300.00 per month

While many studios have gone to 45 minute classes, our dance classes are a minimum of 1 hour long taught by trained professionals. All classes require a minimum of 4 students or they will be cancelled. If a class has less than 6 students, it will end 15 minutes earlier than the published time.

Payment

Payments are due the first of the month whether you receive a bill or not. Bills will be emailed monthly or mailed monthly! **A \$15.00 late fee will be added to your account if your fees (tuition, costume, or recital) are not received by the 10th of the month.** Our monthly tuition rate is calculated based on annual rates and divided into **11** equal monthly installments (August – June). Some months will have 3 weeks and some will have 5 weeks. The holidays when our studio is closed are figured into our tuition rates. Rehearsals at the end of the year are also included in this pay schedule. **If your check is returned for any reason, there is a \$35 returned check fee.**

Calendar

Recital

We have our annual recitals in June 2010 at the Times-Union Performing Arts Center.. The costume deposit is **\$75.00** per costume (1 costume per class) and all costume deposits must be paid for by November 10, 2009. Anyone who has not paid in full by then will be required to pay the late fee. Payments for costumes are non-refundable after costumes have been ordered in December! There are no exceptions. Final costume prices range from \$75to \$90 and **any adjustments will be made in March.. There is a \$65 per student recital fee due in December which is non-refundable. Please note:** We will need helpers backstage for the Senior Show with the younger dancers in Novice level classes. Our Movin' Company Dancers and parents help backstage for the Junior Show.

Attendance

There is no credit or refund given for missed classes, but make-up classes can be arranged with the front desk within one month of the missed class. During the month of May there will not be make-up classes. **Do Not Miss!** **We reserve the right to remove a student from their recital dance due to lack of attendance!**

Withdrawals

You may withdraw from classes with a 30 day written notice to withdraw. We must receive it in our office 30 days prior in order for your account to not be charged the next month's tuition. *Verbal or phone cancellations will not be accepted.*

Dress Code

NO JEWELRY should be worn in any dance class! Male dancers should wear black dance pants, a solid color t-shirt and black shoes for ballet and jazz.

Ballet, Pointe, and Partnering:

Solid color leotard, theatrical pink tights, pink ballet or pointe shoes. Skirts only, no shorts or pants.

Tap: Solid color leotard, tan tights. Combo: Tan tap shoes; Novice: Black Mary Jane tap shoes; Intermediate: Tan heels; Int-2, Adv and Male dancers: Black jazz tap shoes.

Jazz & Theater Dance:

Solid color leotard and tights, black dance shorts or dance pants - No t-shirts.

Combo and Novice levels: Tan jazz shoes; Int - Adv levels: Black jazz shoes.

Males: Black dance pants with a solid t-shirt, black jazz shoes.

Modern: Solid color leotard and convertible tights; bare feet or modern sandals.

Lyrical: Solid color leotard and tights; dance skirt; tan slip-on jazz boot or foot thongs.

Hip Hop: Dance pants and t-shirt, black dance/hip hop sneakers. Knee pads suggested for floor work.
NO JEANS, STREET SHOES OR SNEAKERS ALLOWED!

Tumbling: Any color leotard & footless/convertible tights and bare feet; no baggy clothing and no t-shirts.

All Classes: Please have hair securely pulled back off face and neck. Do not wear necklaces or bracelets to class. Please wear cover-ups to and from the studio (especially older students) to maintain modesty.

Miscellaneous

Please do not leave valuables unattended at the studio. We will not be held responsible for any losses of personal property or valuables.

No gum allowed in studio!

Students should not be dropped off at the studio earlier than 10-15 minutes before class time and must be picked up **promptly**. We do not provide supervision in the waiting room. We ask that you instruct your dancer to wait inside the studio and not walk into the parking lot unattended. We do not want students waiting for their rides outside the studio.

All cell phones should be turned off or silenced in classrooms. If an **emergency** arises and you need to reach your dancer, please call the front desk and we will get them out of class.
