Registration

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$45 for all new students. If a student drops out temporarily (is absent from class for one month) then their spot will be given to the next available student. Upon returning to dance class a registration fee will be required unless a dismissal letter is received thirty days prior to leaving.

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Payment

ALL ACCOUNT MUST HAVE A CARD ON FILE...Monthly tuition is due the first of the month. A \$10.00 late fee will be added to your account after the 5th of the month and the card on file will be charged.

If tuition reaches 3 months past due, that student will lose their place in class(es). The student will need to re-register. The monthly tuition is calculated based on annual rates and divided into monthly installments (August-June). **August is pro-rated; September-June must be paid in full.** Although some months may have more class times than others the payments will remain the same. Rehearsals at the end of the year are also included in the pay schedule. **If your check is returned for any reason, there is a \$30.00 returned check fee.**

Recital

Our annual recital will be held in June 2018. Recital information will be posted when a date is finalized.

The costume fee is as follows:

\$65 for ages 3-4

\$75 for ages 5 and up

There will be an extra charge if a prop, such as a hat is used. Costume fees are non-refundable. Costume payment **is due by October 13, 2017.** There is a **\$10 late fee** after the due date. If you would like to make payments on your costume(s) please note that the full amount must be paid by October 13, 2017 .

There is a non-refundable recital fee of \$75.00 per student **due by February 2th.** There is a **\$10 late fee** applied after the due date. This includes 3 Tickets into the recital. Additional Tickets can be purchased in advanced for \$10. If you would like to make payments on your recital fee please note the full amount must be paid by February 2, 2018.

Attendance

There is no credit or refund given for missed classes. Make-up classes must be schedule **with the front desk.** To make-up a class the student will need to present a make-up ticket to the teacher. Due to recital preparations, during the month of April, May and June make-up classes will not be available. Make-up classes are offered for holidays. Make-up classes are only for the current dance year.

Withdrawals

To prevent paying the registration fee upon returning to dance or guitar class, a written notice is required thirty days prior to leaving

Dress Code

Girls **Hair should be in a bun for ballet classes and pulled back for all other classes!!**

- **Ballet/ Pointe**
Pink tights, black leotard, pink ballet leather ballet shoes ages 3 to 4, Pink canvas Split Sole ballet shoes ages 5+ or pointe shoes. Ballet skirts are allowed, no pants or shorts allowed. For dancers age 3-7 any solid colored leotard and tutus is allowed for their class.
- **Jazz/Hip-Hop/Tap:**
Tan tights, solid colored leotard, dance pants and dance shorts are allowed. Tan Slip On Jazz shoes, Tan Mary Jane/Buckle Tap shoes for ages 3-7 and Black oxford tap shoes for ages 8 and up, black hip-hop dance sneakers
- **Lyrical:** Black leotard, tan Footless tights, tan lyrical shoes.
- **Acro:** Any color leotard, tan tights, white acro shoes.
- **For the 5/7 combination classes,** if ballet is included, the dancers will need to wear the proper ballet attire and the shoes required for the styles of dance they are taking (see above).
- **For the 3/4 combination classes** the dancers will need to wear a solid colored leotard. If ballet is included they will need to wear pink tights and all shoes required for the style of dance they are taking (see above).

Boys: Wear black dance pants, a white t-shirt and black dance shoes that are required for the style of dance.

NO JEWELRY should be worn for any dance class!!! No gum chewing allowed in dance class! Only water is allowed in the dance studios.

Etiquette:

Proper dance attire must be worn at all times. Tights should be worn with dance shorts. Leotards are required. No mid drifts please. Please see dress code for more details. Students must display appropriate classroom behavior at all times, even in the waiting areas. If a student is disruptive, they will be asked to wait in the lobby while their parent/guardian is contacted.

Miscellaneous:

Do not leave valuables unattended. We are not held responsible for loss of personal property. Students must arrive to class on time and must be picked up promptly. All students are to be picked up inside the studio. Cell phones will be turned off during class. Please call the front desk if you need to talk to a *Fascinatin' Rhythm* student.
